



### MassHealth members

MassHealth members may be eligible for non-emergency transportation to and from their medical appointments.

1. In order to get a ride(s) with MassHealth, your healthcare provider needs to submit a PT-1 form (prescription for transportation). Please ask for this during your visit or stay!
2. Once PT-1 is approved, you'll get a letter from your transportation broker (MART or GATRA) with instructions on how to schedule your rides.
